I am requesting funding for Germantown, Englewood, Taylorsville Upstream Dam Walls Rehabilitation. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Miami Conservancy District, located at 38 E. Monument Avenue Dayton, OH 45402. The funding would be used to make critical repairs to address the structural instability of three dams that are currently over 100 years old and past their useful life. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will extend the useful life of these high hazard dams for at least another 75 years, thereby reducing the risk of catastrophic flooding.

This project has a federal nexus because funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133) as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
