

1 (B) develop certification standards and air
2 traffic requirements for unmanned flight oper-
3 ations at test ranges;

4 (C) coordinate with and leverage the re-
5 sources of the National Aeronautics and Space
6 Administration and the Department of Defense;

7 (D) address both civil and public un-
8 manned aircraft systems;

9 (E) ensure that the program is coordinated
10 with the Next Generation Air Transportation
11 System; and

12 (F) provide for verification of the safety of
13 unmanned aircraft systems and related naviga-
14 tion procedures before integration into the na-
15 tional airspace system.

16 (3) TEST RANGE LOCATIONS.—In determining
17 the location of the 6 test ranges of the program
18 under paragraph (1), the Administrator shall—

19 (A) take into consideration geographic and
20 climatic diversity;

21 (B) take into consideration the location of
22 ground infrastructure and research needs; and

23 (C) consult with the National Aeronautics
24 and Space Administration and the Department
25 of Defense.
